ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 OF THE SOLOMON AND GILBERT AND ELLICE ISLANDS AND FAN-NING ISLAND (ALIENS RESTRICTION) REGU-LATION 1915.

1. The High Commissioner may, at any time Power to in writing order the deportation from the Pro-deport Aliens. tectorate or from the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Colony of any alien to any place named in such order; and any alien with respect to whom such an order is made shall be conveyed as soon as may be out of the Protectorate or Colony as aforesaid to the place named as aforesaid, at the cost of the general revenue of the Protectorate or of the Colony of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands if need be, and shall thereafter remain out of the Protectorate or out of the Colony unless permitted by the High Commissioner to return.

2. Where an alien is ordered to be deported Detention of from the Protectorate or from the Colony, as deportation. aforesaid, under these Regulations he may, until he can, in the opinion of the Commissioner, be conveniently conveyed to and placed on board a ship about to leave the Protectorate or Colony, as aforesaid, and whilst being conveyed to the ship and whilst on board the ship until the ship finally sails from the Protectorate or Colony, as aforesaid, be detained in such manner as the Commissioner directs, and whilst so detained shall be deemed to be in legal custody.
