KING'S REGULATION

TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXCLUSION FROM THE BRITISH SOLOMON ISLANDS PROTECTORATE OF DESTITUTE AND UNDESIRABLE PERSONS.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

[29th November, 1922.]

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Undesirable Immigrants Regulation 1922. SHORT TITLE.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to land in the Protectorate unless—
 - (a) he is possessed of a sum of not less than fifty pounds sterling; or
 - (b) is able to satisfy the Resident Commissioner that he is assured of employment and means of subsistence and is not likely to become a charge on the Protectorate.PROOFS REQUIRED OF PERSONS INTENDING TO LAND.
3. The Master or Owner of any vessel who permits any person to land in contravention of this Regulation shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds. PENALTY ON MASTER OR OWNER OF VESSEL FOR CONTRAVENTION.
4. The Master or Owner of any vessel bringing a person to the Colony for whom it is in consequence of this Regulation unlawful to land shall convey such person out of the limits of the Protectorate without cost to the Protectorate. POWER TO CONVEY PROHIBITED PERSON OUT OF PROTECTORATE.

5. It shall be lawful for the Resident Commissioner to cause to be arrested any person who has landed in the Protectorate in contravention of this Regulation and to place him on board the vessel that brought him to the Protectorate to be conveyed therein outside the limits of the Protectorate.
