AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE A SUM NOT EXCEEDING FOUR MILLION AND TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SIX IN ADDITION TO THE SUMS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR THAT YEAR

ENACTED by the Parliament of Fiji-

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the 1986 Supplementary Appropriation (No. 4) Act, 1986.

Supplementary Appropriation of \$4,027,600

- 2.—(1) There shall be issued from the Consolidated Fund, and other funds of Fiji, and applied to the service of the year ending 31 December, one thousand nine hundred and eighty-six any sum or sums not exceeding the sum of four million and twenty-seven thousand, six hundred dollars for defraying the charges of the Government of Fiji for such period, in addition to the sums previously appropriated for that year.
 - (2) The said amount shall be appropriated as set out in the Schedules.
