## Extension of Declaration of Biosecurity Emergency Areas for American Iguana

(Iguana iguana)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 77(1) of the Biosecurity Promulgation 2008, with the advice of the Biosecurity Authority of Fiji and in consultation with the National Disaster Management Council, I hereby extend the Declaration of Biosecurity Emergency Areas for American Iguana (*Iguana iguana*) published as Legal Notice No. 4 of 2014 for the whole islands of Qamea, Matagi, Taveuni and Laucala.

The extension of the Declaration is for a period of six (6) months with effect from 24 July 2014.

Movements of all stages of American Iguana including its eggs into and out of the declared Biosecurity Emergency Areas is strictly prohibited.

Pursuant to sections 79(3) and 94(2) and (3) of the Biosecurity Promulgation 2008, any person who acts in breach of any direction made pursuant to this extended Declaration, commits an offence and shall be liable to the penalties prescribed under Schedule 5 of the Biosecurity Promulgation 2008.
