COMMERCE COMMISSION DECREE 2010

**Commerce Commission (On-Spot Penalties)
Regulations 2011**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 158 of the Commerce Commission Decree 2010, I make the following Regulations—

Short title and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Commerce Commission (On-Spot Penalties) Regulations 2011 and are deemed to have come into effect on the commencement date of the Commerce Commission Decree 2010.

Repeal

2. The Commerce Commission (On-Spot Penalties) Regulations 2010 is hereby repealed.

Form

3. For the purposes of section 59(1) the prescribed On-Spot Penalty Form is set out in Schedule 1.
