CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF FIJI
(Section 92(3))

Ministerial Assignment

To: Mr Manoa Seru Nakausabaria Kamikamica
Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Trade, Co-operatives and Small and Medium Enterprises, and Communications

In exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I hereby assign to you in your capacity as the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Trade, Co-operatives and Small and Medium Enterprises, and Communications, with effect from 24 December 2022, the responsibility for the conduct of the following Government businesses, divisions and written laws (subject to the provisions of any other written law)—
