# CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF FIJI (Section 92(3))

## **Ministerial Assignment**

To: Mr. Sitiveni Ligamamada Rabuka

Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs, Climate Change, Environment, Civil Service, Information, Public Enterprises and Veteran Affairs

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I assigned to myself in my capacity as the Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs, Climate Change, Environment, Civil Service, Information, Public Enterprises and Veteran Affairs with effect from 24 December 2022, the responsibility for the conduct of Government businesses, divisions and written laws specified in Legal Notice No. 1 of 2023;

Now Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I hereby revoke with effect from 1 August 2023, all assignments and responsibilities under Legal Notice No. 1 of 2023, and with effect from the same day assign to myself in my capacity as the Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs, Climate Change, Environment, Civil Service, Information, Public Enterprises and Veteran Affairs the responsibility for the conduct of the following Government businesses, divisions and written laws (subject to the provisions of any other written law)—
