CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF FIJI (Section 92(3))

Ministerial Assignment

To: Mr Faiyaz S. Koya Minister for Commerce, Trade, Tourism and Transport

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I assigned to you in your capacity as the Minister for Commerce, Trade, Tourism and Transport with effect from 17 April 2020, the responsibility for the conduct of Government businesses, divisions and written laws specified in Legal Notice No. 39 of 2020;

Now THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I hereby revoke with effect from 24 August 2021, all assignments and responsibilities under Legal Notice No. 39 of 2020, and with effect from the same day assign to you in your capacity as the Minister for Commerce, Trade, Tourism and Transport the responsibility for the conduct of the following Government businesses, divisions and written laws (subject to the provisions of any other written law)—
