## ROYAL FIJI MILITARY FORCES ACT (CHAPTER 81)



FIJI MILITARY FORCES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1992

inexercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 67 of the Royal Fiji Military Forces Act, I have made the following Regulations:

Short title, interpretation

- 1.-(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Fiji Military Forces (Amendment) Regulations, 1992.
- (2) In these Regulations the Royal Fiji Military Regulations is reffered to as the "principal regulations".

Regulation 19 amended

- 2. Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is amended by:
- (a) substituting the figure "55" for the figure "47" in paragraph 1 (a); (b) substituting the figure "55" for the figure "50" in paragraph 1 (b); and
- (c) substituting the figure "55" for the figure "50" in paragraph 1 (c).

Coming into force

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the date it is published in the Fiji Republic Gazette.

B" of the Table Permits.
