· KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE GILBERT AND ELLICE ISLANDS (TAXATION AMENDMENT) REGULATION, 1912.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific in accordance with the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council, 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

- 1. This Regulation may be cited as the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Short title. (Taxation Amendment) Regulation, 1915.
- 2. Section three of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands (Taxation Amendment of Amendment) Regulation, 1912, is hereby amended by the insertion, section 3 of Regulation after the word "year" in the last line thereof, of the words "without the approval of the High Commissioner."
