KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND "THE GILBERT AND ELLICE ISLANDS PRO-TECTORATE (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATION 1908."

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific in accordance with the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council, 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, GEORGE V., of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. THIS Regulation may be cited as the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Short title. (Import Duties Amendment) Regulation 1910.

2. Schedule M. to "The Gilbert and Ellice Islands Protectorate Amends Reg. No. 3 (Consolidation) Regulation 1908 " is hereby amended by the insertion ^{of 1908, Schedule M.} therein, after the words "smaller quantities " in the last line thereof, of the following words and figures, that is to say :—
