AN ACT

To further amend title 53 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-120 and 6-111, by further amending section 806, as amended by Public Law No. 5-120, to allow a surviving spouse to receive social security benefits based on his or her own employment coverage if it pays more than survivors' benefits, and that this amount plus any children's survivors' benefits may exceed the amount of the deceased's retirement benefits, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 806 of title 53 of the Code of the Federated 1 2 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 5-120, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 806. Amount of survivor insurance benefits. 4 5 (1) The surviving spouse of a fully insured worker 6 eligible in accordance with section 802 shall be paid a 7 monthly benefit or disability in an amount equal to sixty 8 percent of the retirement or disability insurance benefit

10 (2) Each eligible child of an insured worker shall be 11 entitled to a monthly benefit of fifteen percent of the 12 retirement insurance benefit calculated for the deceased 13 parent at the date of death.

calculated for the deceased spouse at the date of death.

14 (3) If the spouse of the deceased insured worker is
15 eligible for retirement or disability benefits based
16 on his or her own employment coverage, and is also eligible
17 for survivors' benefits, the spouse shall receive whatever
18 benefit pays the largest monthly payment.

(4) The total survivors' benefit paid to the spouse
and children may not exceed the retirement benefit
calculated for the decedent as of the date of death,
except that if the surviving spouse receives benefits

8 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the 9 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming 10 law without such approval.
