

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 2-34, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35, 3-50, 4-79, 5-11, 6-106, 8-10 and 8-36, to modify the use of funds previously appropriated therein for certain public projects in the Mortlocks, Chuuk State; by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3-17, 4-15, 5-26, 6-106, 7-12 and 8-12, for the purpose of changing the allottee of funds appropriated therein; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 2-34, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35, 3-50, 4-79, 5-11, 6-106, 8-10 and  
3 8-36, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$846,200, or so much thereof as may  
5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
6 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
7 ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of funding  
8 certain public projects in the State of Truk. The sum  
9 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as  
10 follows:

5 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 2-34, as amended by  
 6 Public Laws Nos. 3-17, 4-15, 5-26, 6-106, 7-12 and 8-12, is hereby  
 7 further amended to read as follows:

8 "Section 2. The allottees for all public projects in the  
 9 State of Chuuk shall be the development authorities for  
 10 the respective areas of the State of Chuuk; PROVIDED,  
 11 however, that the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
 12 subsection (2) of section 1 of this act shall be the Faichuk  
 13 PWP Development Authority, that the allottee of the funds  
 14 appropriated under subsection (4) of section 1 of this act  
 15 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State, and that the allottee  
 16 of the funds appropriated under subsection (5) of section 1  
 17 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development  
 18 Authority."

19 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
 20 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
 21 law without such approval.
