

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-071, 10-46, 10-69, 10-106 and 11-29, to change the uses of Chuuk State funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 9-071, 10-46, 10-69, 10-106 and 11-29, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as may  
5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of  
6 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
7 September 30, 1996, for the purpose of funding infrastructure  
8 needs, transportation systems, and other economic and social  
9 projects, public projects and for other purposes in Chuuk  
10 State and for Chuukese outside of Chuuk State. The funds  
11 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as  
12 follows:

13 (1) Statewide projects, other than salaries,  
14 travel, and vehicles

- 15 (a) Power generation upgrade or
- 16 purchase..... \$ 750,000
- 17 (b) Hospital generator fuel..... 50,000
- 18 (c) CIP supplemental..... 75,000
