AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 15-32, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78, 16-03 and 16-11, by amending Section 1 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the State of Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-32, as amended by
2	Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78, 16-03,
3	and 16-11 is hereby further amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 1. The sum of \$3,780,000, or so much thereof,
5	is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
6	Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
7	ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose of funding
8	public projects and social programs in each State of the
9	Federated States of Micronesia. The fund shall be
10	apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or less per member
11	of Congress as follows, PROVIDED THAT an increase of
12	\$300,000 is for Yap State.
