

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$5,450,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the states of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. The sum of \$5,450,000, or so much thereof as may  
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the  
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
4 September 30, 2017, for the purpose funding public projects and  
5 social programs in the states of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk.  
6 The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as  
7 follows:

8           Section 2. Of the sum of \$5,450,000 appropriated by this  
9 act, \$600,000 is apportioned for public projects and social  
10 programs in the state of Yap.

13 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
14 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,  
15 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with  
16 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial  
17 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for  
18 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
19 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this  
20 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
21 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
22 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State;  
23 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under section  
24 2(k) shall be the President of the Federated States of  
25 Micronesia. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections

1 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated  
2 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the  
3 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) through  
4 3(r) - shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government; the  
5 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(aa) - 3(a6)  
6 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee of  
7 funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(l), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(f)  
8 and 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation  
9 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under  
10 subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(g),  
11 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(l) and 4(2)(m) shall  
12 be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,  
13 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee  
14 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(b) shall be the  
15 Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of funds  
16 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) shall be the Office of  
17 Fisheries, Pohnpei State; the allottee of funds appropriated  
18 under subsection 4(2)(n) shall be the Secretary of the  
19 Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of funds  
20 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(b) shall be the Governor of  
21 the State of Pohnpei or his designee; the allottee of funds  
22 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(c) and 4(3)(e) of this act  
23 shall be the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; allottee of funds  
24 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(m) shall be the  
25 Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of funds appropriated

1 under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the  
2 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
3 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the  
4 Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
5 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the  
6 Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
7 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the  
8 Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the allottee  
9 to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on  
10 September 30, 2018.

11 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
12 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
13 becoming law without such approval.
