PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-43

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$4,200,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$4,200,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4 September 30, 2019, for the purpose of funding public projects and
5 social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk
6 states. The funds appropriated under this section shall be
7 apportioned as follows:

8 Section 2. Of the \$4,200,000 appropriated under this act,
9 \$600,000 shall be apportioned for public projects and social
10 programs for the people of Yap State.

9 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
10 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
11 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
12 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
13 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
14 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
15 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
16 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
17 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
18 Governor of Yap State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee
19 of funds appropriated under subsection 2(f) of this act shall be
20 the President of the COM-FSM Institute. The allottee of funds
21 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the
22 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
23 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
24 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his
25 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2)

1 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
2 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)
3 and 4(3)(1) of this act shall be the Vice President. The allottee
4 of funds appropriated under section 4(2) of this act shall be the
5 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and
6 Infrastructure or his designee, except that the allottee of funds
7 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(e), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(m), 4(4)(j),
8 4(4)(k), 4(4)(l) and 4(4)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
9 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
10 under subsections 4(2)(l), 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(f) of this act shall
11 be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his designee;
12 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(h) of
13 this act shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of funds
14 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(h),
15 4(3)(i) and 4(3)(k) of this act shall be the Meninkeder of
16 Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
17 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the Chief Justice of Madolenihmw
18 Municipal Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of
20 Kitti; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(j)
21 of this act shall be the Speaker of Isokonedi of Kitti. The
22 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 5(1), 5(3) and
23 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
24 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
25 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development

1 Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated under
2 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
3 Development Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated
4 under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
5 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
6 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2022.

7 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9 becoming law without such approval.
