

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 20-95, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-173 and 21-47, by amending sections 2 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriate therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
