## AN ACT

23	Public Laws Nos. 21-01 and 21-36, 21-53 and 21-56, is here	eby
24	amended to read as follows:	

"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
State or his designee. The allottee of funds
appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT
the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of
COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(ak) of this
act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 3(al) of this act shall be the Secretary of
the FSM Department of Education or his designee. The
allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this
act shall be the President of the Federated States of
Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee

of funds appropriated under section 4(1) and subsection
4(3)(w) of this act shall be the Vice President of the
Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; allottee
of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(v) of this
act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town Government or his
designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsections $4(3)(a)$ , $4(3)(b)$ and $4(3)(c)$ of this act
shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and
Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and
4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(u), 4(4)(f),
4(3)(p) and 4(3)(ab) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
Transportation Authority: the funds appropriated under
subsection 4(3)(ac) of this act shall be Lukenmenlap of
Kitti; the funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(g)
of this act shall be the President of the Federated
States of Micronesia or his designee, the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsection $4(3)(x)$ of this act
shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal
Government or his designee; the funds appropriated under
subsections $4(3)(i)$ and $4(3)(j)$ of this act shall be the
Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; The

1	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
2	5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of
3	Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds
4	appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
5	the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the
6	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4
7	of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
8	Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
9	subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
10	Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
11	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
12	September 30, 2020."
13	Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15	becoming law without such approval.
