CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 3-46, C.D.1

---

AN ACT

To amend section 207 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia by adding new subsections requiring certain public officials whose appointments are subject to advice and consent of the Congress to submit their resignations to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 207 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated  
2 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:

3               "Section 207. Appointment authority.

4                       (1) The President shall nominate and, with the advice  
5 and consent of the Congress, as provided in article X,  
6 section 2(d), of the Constitution, shall appoint the  
7 secretaries of departments and their deputies, if any, and  
8 the heads of the offices of the Attorney General, Budget,  
9 Planning and Statistics, and the Public Defender, and their  
10 deputies, if any, including the secretaries, deputies, and  
11 heads of departments and offices established by subsequent  
12 law; provided that nothing herein shall be construed to  
13 require the appointment of the deputies named above.

14                      (2) The President or his designee may appoint officers  
15 and employees not included in subsection (1) of this section,  
16 without advice and consent of the Congress; provided that  
17 such appointments are not inconsistent with the provisions  
18 of this chapter or other laws of the Federated States.

19                      (3) The President shall not resubmit the nomination of  
20 any person to the Congress for its action if the same Congress  
21 shall have previously rejected such nomination, unless the  
22 Congress shall by resolution authorize such resubmission.
