To appropriate the sum of \$382,500 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1985, for the purpose of funding public projects in the State of Yap, and for other purposes.

1	Section 1. The sum of \$382,500, or so much thereof as may be
2	necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Feder-
3	ated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
4	1985, for the purpose of funding public projects in the State of Yap.
5	The funds appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:
6	(1) Wottegai taro patch reclamation \$ 7,000

22	Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,

1	managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
2	law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
3	1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds,
4	or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
5	specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
6	of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate
7	funds appropriated by this act shall remain available until expended.
8	The allottee may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds
9	appropriated to each of the subsections in section 1.
10	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
11	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
12	law without such approval.
