CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 3-269, C.D.1, C.D.2

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 2-60 to establish imprest revolving funds for the Federated States of Micronesia Representative Office in Washington, D.C., and the Japan Economic Liaison Office, to authorize the use of the sum of \$40,000 therefor, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 2-60 is hereby amended to 1 2 read as follows: 3 "Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to establish five ongoing imprest revolving funds to provide, subject to 4 5 the provisions of section 4 of this act, sources of advanced 6 funding for authorized operations expenses of the Guam and Honolulu Liaison Offices, the Federated States of Micronesia 8 Representative Office, and the Japan Economic Liaison Office 9 and authorized expenses incurred during official travel by 10 qualified Community College of Micronesia employees and officials, National and State Government employees and 11 12 officials, and medical referral patients and their attendants." Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 2-60 is hereby amended to 13 read as follows: 14 15 "Section 3. Establishment. 16 (1) There is hereby established an ongoing imprest 17 revolving fund within the General Fund for each of the following offices of the National Government of the Federated States of 18 19 Micronesia: 20 (a) Guam Liaison Office; 21 (b) Honolulu Liaison Office;

(c) San Francisco Supply Office;

1	(d) Federated States of Micronesia Representative
2	Office; and
3	(e) Japan Economic Liaison Office."
4	Section 3. Section 4 of Public Law No. 2-60 is hereby amended to
5	read as follows:
6	"Section 4. Authorized uses of the funds.
7	(1) The fund established pursuant to section 3 of this
8	act for the Guam Liaison Office may be utilized as a source
9	of advanced funding for authorized expenses incurred in the
LO	operation of that office.
1.1	(2) The fund established pursuant to section 3 of this
L2	act for the Honolulu Liaison Office may be utilized as a
1.3	source of advanced funding for authorized expenses incurred in
L4	the operation of that office.
L5	(3) The fund established pursuant to section 3 of this
1.6	act for the Federated States of Micronesia Representative
1.7	Office may be utilized as a source of advanced funding for
18	authorized expenses incurred in the operation of that office.
L9	(4) The fund established pursuant to section 3 of this
20	act for the Japan Economic Liaison Office may be utilized as
21	a source of advanced funding for authorized expenses incurred
22	in the operation of that office.
23	(5) All of the funds established pursuant to section 3
24	of this act may be utilized as sources of advanced funding for
2.5	authorized expenses incurred during travel by:

1	(a) Employees and officials of the Community College
2	of Micronesia and employees and officials of any branch, depart-
3	ment, office, board, bureau, commission, committee, institution,
4	corporation, or statutory authority of the National or State
5	Governments of the Federated States of Micronesia who have been
6	issued valid travel authorizations; and
7	(b) Medical referral patients and their attendants
8	who have been issued valid travel authorizations.
9	(6) The Secretary of Finance of the National Government
10	of the Federated States of Micronesia shall determine 'authorized
11	expenses' for the purposes of subsections (1) through (5) of
12	this section through the establishment of policies and procedures.
13	(7) The funds shall not be utilized for any purpose other
14	than as permitted by this section."
15	Section 4. Section 7 of Public Law No. 2-60 is hereby repealed
16	in its entirety.
17	Section 5. Section 8 of Public Law No. 2-60 is hereby amended to read
18	as follows:
19	"Section 8. Authorization.
20	(1) The sum of \$87,000, or so much thereof as may be
21	necessary, is hereby authorized to be used within the General
22	Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of
23	funding the imprest revolving funds. The sums authorized by
24	this subsection shall be apportioned as follows:
25	(a) Guam Liaison Office \$ 20,000

1	(b) Honolulu Liaison Office \$ 20,000
2	(c) San Francisco Supply Office 7,000
3	(d) Federated States of Micronesia
4	Representative Office
5	(e) Japan Economic Liaison Office 20,000
6	(2) All funds authorized by this act shall be allotted,
7	managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
8	applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
9	Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible
10	for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
12	act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
13	sum authorized."
14	Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
15	of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without
16	such approval.
