CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 4-86

#### AN ACT

To further amend section 1 of Public Law No. 3-56, as amended by Public Law No. 3-71, to change the purpose for which funds were appropriated under section 1(8)(n), and for other purposes.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 3-56, as amended by Public
