AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

8	Section 4. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
9	managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
LO	law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
1	1979. The allottee for the funds apportioned under subsections (1),
12	(2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), (10), (11), (12), (13), (15),
13	and (16) of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State.
14	The allottee for the funds apportioned under subsection (14) of section
15	2 of this act shall be the chairman of the Yap congressional delegation.
16	The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or
17	so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes
18	specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
19	of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate
20	funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1986.
