AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 2-34, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35 and 3-50, to change the purpose for which funds were appropriated under subsection (5) (b)(v), and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
