CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 4-58, C.D.1, C.D.2

AN ACT

To further amend title 11 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-71, 3-63, and 3-75, by amending section 301 relating to liability for crimes of another, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 301 of title 11 of the Code of the Federated

 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:

 "Section 301. Liability for crimes of another.

 (1) A person is criminally liable for the conduct of another, if:
 - (a) he intentionally aids, abets, advises, solicits, counsels, or conspires with or otherwise procures the other to commit an offense; or
 - (b) while acting with the state of mind that is sufficient for the commission of the offense, he causes an innocent or irresponsible person to engage in such conduct; or
 - (c) having a legal duty to prevent the commission of an offense, he fails to make proper effort to do so.
 - (2) A person liable under subsection (1) of this section is also liable for any other offense committed in the pursuance of the intended crime if reasonably foreseeable by him as a probable consequence of committing or attempting to commit the offense intended.
 - (3) A person liable under this section may be charged with and convicted of the offense although the person who directly committed it has not been prosecuted or convicted,

1	or has been convicted of a different offense or degree of
2	offense.
3	(4) No person may be convicted under this section
4	unless the information specifically alleges that the
5	defendant aided and abetted and that said information
6	provides specific acts constituting the means of aiding and
7	abetting so as to afford the defendant adequate notice to
8	prepare his defense."
9	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
11	law without such approval.
