AN ACT

To further amend title 9 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 5-70, by amending section 706 for the purpose of providing for exceptions to the seven day's notice requirement for voting at a polling place other than the one at which a voter is legally registered to vote, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Section 706 of title 9 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: 2 3 "Section 706. Voting at another polling place. 4 (1) A voter shall have the right to vote on election 5 day at a polling place other than the polling place at which he is legally registered to vote if the following conditions 6 7 are met: 8 (a) the voter is present in his State on the day 9 of election; 10 (b) he is lawfully registered to vote in his 11 representative or election district; and 12 (c) he notifies the national election 13 commissioner in writing at least seven days before the 14 election that he will not be voting in his proper voting 15 place and that he requests to vote at a specific voting 16 place. (2) Upon receipt of voter's request for a change in 17 18 polling place, and no later than five days from such 19 receipt if request is made seven days before the election, 20 the national election commissioner shall immediately 21 assign and notify the voter by any means of communication, 22 including the use of radio, as to the place where the voter

may vote. Upon such notification, the voter shall be 1 permitted to vote only at that polling place. 2 3 (3) The national election commissioner shall cause a mark to be placed next to the name of the voter in that 4 part of the General State Register for the election 5 6 precinct or the polling place where the voter would normally cast his ballot. This mark shall indicate that 7 8 the voter will be casting his ballot at another polling 9 place and that he is prohibited from voting in that 10 election at his usual polling place. The national election 11 commissioner shall provide the proper ballot at the newly 12 designated polling place for each voter who complies with the provisions of this section. 13 14 (4) The seven day notice requirement in subsection (1) of this section may be waived by the national election 15 16 commissioner if the following conditions are met: (a) the voter was unable to give sufficient 17 18 notice because circumstances beyond his control made 19 it impossible or extremely difficult to do so; (b) the voter gives at least one day's notice in 20 writing; and 21 22 (c) the waiver would not prevent compliance 23 with any other provision of this section." 24 25
