(3) 30 Specific or unit tax shall be paid on quantity, weight or volume; and ad valorem (4) 31 tax shall be paid on the cost, insurance and freight (C.I.F.) value of the goods as 32 per rates given below; provided, however, that in respect to goods imported on

1	(a)	"Foodstuffs" means all consumables including sugar and sugar confectionery,		
.2		animal products, canned foods, snacks foods, bakery items, prepared cereals,		
3		condiments such as salt, pepper, spices, cooking oil and ketchup.		
4	(b)	The following products shall be exempt from import duties under this Act: milk		
.5		(fresh and evaporated); soy milk; rice; flour; fresh, frozen and canned vegetables;		
6		fruit; baby food products; poultry (excluding turkey tail); and canned fish		
.7		products.		
8	(c)	"New Motor Vehicle" means a motor vehicle which (1) has not previously been		
9		sold to any person except a distributor, wholesaler, or dealer for resale, except		
20		where the vehicle has not left the dealer's possession after the sale to a consumer		

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(2) has not been previously registered or titled in the name of a consumer except

where the vehicle has not left the dealer's possession after the sale to a consumer,

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1	and (3) has not been driven more than two thousand (2000) miles; provided that			
2	where a sale, registration, entitlement, or transfer of title of a motor vehicle, or the			
3	accrual of mileage thereon, is primarily for the purpose of evading this provision			
4	the motor vehicle shall be deemed a new motor vehicle for the purpose of this			
5	Act.			
6	(d) Used motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle other than a new motor vehicle."

8	Section 3.	Effective Date		
9	This Act shall take effect in accordance with the Constitution and the Rules of			
10	Procedures of the Nitijela.
