P.L. 2014 - 33 1 AN ACT 2 3 To amend Section 268 of the Judiciary Act 1983, 27 MIRC Chp. 2, which defines and prohibits 4 "outside employment" of judges to allow practicing attorneys to serve as pro tem judges and to 5 expressly provide that judges may represent themselves; and to amend Section 278 of the 6 Judiciary Act to permit the Office of the Attorney-General to represent the Judiciary as mutually 7 agreed. 8 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS: 10 Section 1: Short Title. This Act may be cited as the Judiciary (Representation Amendment) Act, 2014. 11 12 Section 2: Amendment. Subsection 268 of the Judiciary Act 1983, 27 MIRC 2 is amended to read as 13 (1)follows: 14 §268. Outside employment. 15 16 (1)Subject to Subsections (3).
