13	Subsection 303(2) of the Traditional Rights Court (Composition and Appointments) Act	
14	1985, 27 MIRC Chp.3, is amended to read as follows:	
15		(2) The Chief Judge and Associate Judges of the permanent
16		panel appointed under Subsection (1) shall hold office during good
