

A N O R D I N A N C E.

To amend the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1937-1939.

I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article I of the Agreement dated the second day of July, 1919, between the Government of the United Kingdom, the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, hereby make the following Ordinance.

MOTOR TRAFFIC ORDINANCE 1959.

1.--(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1959.

(2.) The Motor Traffic Ordinance 1937-1939, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1937-1959.

2. After section thirty-two of the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1937-1939, the following section is inserted:-

"32A. A person shall not ride upon a public highway at any time between sunset and sunrise any bicycle which has not -

- (a) a lighted lamp attached to the bicycle in such a manner and position as to show a bright white light clearly visible to any person approaching from the front; and
- (b) a red reflector attached to the bicycle in such a manner and position as to reflect the lights of any vehicle approaching from the rear."
