

THE ISLAND OF NAURU

No. 1 of 1954.

A N O R D I N A N C E

To amend the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951.

BE it ordained by the Acting Administrator of the Island of Nauru acting in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 1 of the Agreement dated the second day of July, 1919, between the Government of the United Kingdom, the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1.(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1954.

(2.) The Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951-1954.

Remuneration
of Head Chief
and Councillors.

2. Section fifty of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (2.) and by inserting in its stead the following sub-section:

"(2.) Where during any month the Head Chief or a Councillor has not attended a majority of meetings of the Council, he shall not, unless he has been granted leave by the Administrator, be entitled to any allowance in respect of that month:

Provided that no allowance shall be paid in respect of the month in which the Head Chief or a Councillor is deemed to have vacated his office in accordance with the provisions of section thirty-seven of this Ordinance."
