AN ORDINANCE

To Grant and Apply a Sum out of the Revenues of the Territory to the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Terri-Preamble. tory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation short title. Ordinance, 1919-1920.
- 2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Revenues of Issue and the Territory and apply towards making good the supply application, hereby granted to His Majesty for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty the sum of One Hundred and Nine Thousand One Hundred and Fifty-two Pounds' for the purposes and Services expressed in the First Schedule.
- 3. In addition to the sums specified in the First Advances for Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and of the Supply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of

June One thousand nine hundred and twenty as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Appropriation of Loan and Grant Funds. £8,662.

4. The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan and Grant Funds of the Territory towards the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty the sums mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto for the purposes specified therein.
