To Grant and Apply a Sum out of the Revenues of the Territory to the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council of the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act*, 1905-1924, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation short title. Ordinance, 1932-1933.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Revenues of Issue and the Territory and apply towards making good the supply application, hereby granted to His Majesty for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, the sum of One Hundred and Thirty-Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen Pounds.

Appropriation Ordinance, 1932-1933.

Appropriation of supplies, £130,919.

Advances for the purposes of the Second Schedule. **3.** All sums granted by the last preceding section of this Ordinance out of the Revenues of the Territory towards making good the supply granted His Majesty amounting to the sum of One Hundred and Thirty Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen Pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to be appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, for the purposes and services expressed in the First Schedule.

4. In addition to the sum specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Appropriation of Trust, Loan and Grant Funds, £5,350.

5. The Treasurer may issue out of the Trust Loan and Grant Funds of the Territory towards the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, the sums mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto for the purposes specified therein.
