AN ORDINANCE

To Grant and Apply a Sum out of the Revenues of the Territory to the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-one, and to Appropriate the Supplies already Granted for such Year.

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Terri-Preamble. tory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Papua Act, 1905-1934, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation short title. Ordinance, 1940-1941.
- 2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Revenues of Issue and apply towards making good the supply application, thereby granted to His Majesty for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-one, the sum of One Hundred and Forty-two Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty-two Pounds.
- 3. In addition to the sum of Thirty Thousand Appropriation Pounds granted by the Supply Ordinance, 1940-1941, all \$\frac{4172,432}{2172,432}\$.

sums granted by the last preceding section of this Ordinance out of the Revenues of the Territory towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty amounting in the aggregate to the sum of One Hundred and Seventy-two Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty-two Pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to be appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty, for the purposes and services expressed in the First Schedule.

Advances for the purposes of the Second Schedule. 4. In addition to the sum specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-one, as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Appropriation of Trust, Loan and Grant Funds, £6,080.

5. The Treasurer may issue out of the Trust Loan and Grant Funds of the Territory towards the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-one, the sums mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto for the purposes specified therein.
