No. 7 of 1931. AN ORDINANCE

To Provide for the Imposition of a General Customs Duty on Imports.

B^E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (Gen-short title and eral Import Duty) Ordinance, 1931, and shall be incorporated and read as one with the Customs Ordinance, 1909-1916.

2. (1) In addition to any Customs dues under any General duty. laws now in force or that hereafter may be in force in the Territory there shall be charged collected and paid to the use of the King for the purposes of the Territory of Papua on all goods imported into the Territory of whatsoever description whether dutiable or free of duty a general duty at the rate of four per centum on the value of such goods. goods were subject to ad valorem duty. Ordinance. **3.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may at any

time by Proclamation published in the Gazette notify specified goods as free from the general duty payable under this Ordinance and from the date of such publication no general duty under this Ordinance shall be payable.

4. The Treasurer may at his discretion permit the delivery of perishable goods notwithstanding that the general duty payable under this Ordinance has not been paid at the time of such delivery.

5. The Lieutenant-Governor may by Proclamation published in the Gazette suspend the operation of this Ordinance either for a period specified in the Proclamation or during the continuance thereof.

6. The Lieutenant-Governor may from time to time by Proclamation published in the *Gazette* reduce the rate of the general duty imposed under this Ordinance such reduction may be for a period specified in the Proclamation or during the continuance thereof.

7. The time of imposition of the general duty imposed by this Ordinance shall be the sixteenth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, at ten o'clock in the forenoon reckoned according to standard time in the Territory of Papua and this Ordinance shall be deemed to come into operation at that time.
