## AN ORDINANCE

*Relating to Duties of Customs.*

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1934*, as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Customs (Export) Tariff, 1940.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Customs (Export) Tariff, 1937*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The *Customs (Export) Tariff, 1925-1936*, as amended by the Principal Ordinance and by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Customs (Export) Tariff, 1925-1940.*

**2.** After Section Three of the Principal Ordinance the following new section is inserted:—

Deduction of  
Federal tax  
from value.

“3A. Notwithstanding the provisions of the *Customs Ordinance, 1909-1939*, the *ad valorem* value of gold for the purposes of duty under this Ordinance shall not include any sum paid in direct taxation upon such gold pursuant to any law of the Commonwealth of Australia.”

**3.** This Ordinance shall commence upon the date fixed for the commencement of the Principal Ordinance.
