AN ORDINANCE

*To Amend the Laws Relating to Goldfields, Mineral Lands,
Mines and Mining.*

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Mining Ordinance, 1924.* Short title.

2. Section Two hundred and forty-seven of *The Mining Act of 1898* (Queensland Adopted) is amended by inserting therein after Paragraph (45) thereof the following new paragraphs:—

“(45A) Prescribing the appliances and remedies to be kept at mines for the relief of persons injured ;

(45B) Providing for the protection of health and regulating the sanitary conditions of mines, including the examination and exclusion of persons likely to be infected with infectious or transmissible diseases ;

- (45C) Providing for the safe handling of materials particularly hot furnace products ;
- (45D) The use of electricity and electrical machinery ; prescribing the rules and precautions to be used."

Passed in Council this twenty-second day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four.
