AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the Law Relating to Mining.

[RESERVED 10TH JULY, 1934;
ASSENTED TO 3RD OCTOBER, 1934.]^(a)

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act*, 1905-1924, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Mining Ordinance*, 1934, and shall be read with *The Mining Act of 1898* (Queensland Adopted) and other Ordinances relating to mining. Short title and construction.

2. Subsection (3) of Section Five of *The Mining Ordinance of 1907* is amended by omitting therefrom the words “engaged by contract of service under an Ordinance relating to native labour.” Amendment of s. 5 (3) of Ordinance IV of 1908.

3. Section Six of *The Mining Ordinance of 1907* is amended by omitting therefrom the words "engaged as mentioned in the last section."
