# AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "*Mineral Oil and Coal Ordinance, 1923.*"

[RESERVED 13TH DECEMBER, 1923;  
ASSENTED TO 20TH DECEMBER, 1923.]<sup>(a)</sup>

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Mineral Oil and Coal Ordinance* (No. 2), 1923. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Mineral Oil and Coal Ordinance, 1923*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Mineral Oil and Coal Ordinances, 1923*.
