AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Ordinance, 1923."

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Ordinance, 1926.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Ordinance, 1923*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Ordinance, 1923-1926.*

2. Section Six of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from Subsection (2) thereof the words "or subsequently endorsed."

Amendment of

3. Section Eleven of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by inserting in Subsection (1) thereof after the word "legislature" the words "or other competent authority";
- (b) by adding thereto the following new subsection:—

“(3) For the purposes of this section the expression “part of His Majesty’s Dominions outside the United Kingdom” shall be deemed to include and always to have included any territory which is under His Majesty’s protection or in respect of which a mandate is being exercised by the Government of any part of His Majesty’s Dominions.”
