AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Native Labour Ordinance, 1911-1927.

[RESERVED 13TH DECEMBER, 1930;
ASSENTED TO 13TH MARCH, 1931.]^(a)

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Native Labour Ordinance, 1930.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Native Labour Ordinance, 1911-1927*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Native Labour Ordinance, 1911-1930.*

2. Section 94 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following Section substituted in lieu thereof:—

“94. The Lieutenant-Governor may make regulations prescribing the fees to be charged employers Fees to be prescribed.

under the provisions of this Ordinance in respect of the several matters hereinafter set out:—

- (a) For every native on entering into a Contract of Service;
- (b) Statement, Form E, for each native named therein;
- (c) Permit, Form H, for each native named therein;
- (d) Permit, Form I, for each native named therein;
- (e) Permit, Form J, for each native named therein;
- (f) Certificate, Form K;
- (g) Guarantee for every ten or less than ten natives referred to therein;
- (h) For every copy of Contract of Service in lieu of employer's copy lost or destroyed.

3. Schedule M of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.
