AN ORDINANCE

*To Amend the "Navigation Ordinance, 1889-1937."*

[RESERVED 29TH JULY, 1938;  
ASSENTED TO 5TH OCTOBER, 1938.]<sup>(a)</sup>

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1934*, as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Navigation Ordinance, 1938*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Navigation Ordinance, 1889-1937*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Navigation Ordinance, 1889-1938*.

**2.** Immediately after Section One hundred and sixty-eight of the Principal Ordinance the following new section is inserted:—

Boats with  
explosives  
to be in charge  
of European.

“168A. Every boat used for the conveyance of gunpowder or other explosive substance shall be under the immediate charge of a man of European descent unless the consent in writing of the Treasurer to the contrary is first obtained: Provided that nothing in this section shall extend to a boat conveying explosive substance of a less weight than fifty pounds.”

**3.** Section One hundred and eighty of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following further proviso:—

“Provided further that the Lieutenant-Governor may by order in council published in the *Gazette* authorize the construction of the store or magazine with materials other than those specified in this section.”

Passed in Council this twenty-ninth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight.
