AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "Papuan Antiquities Ordinance, 1913-1939."

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act*, 1905-1934, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Papuan Short title and Antiquities Ordinance, 1940.
- (2) The Papuan Antiquities Ordinance, 1913-1939, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Papuan Antiquities Ordinance*, 1913-1940.

Amendment of Section 2 of Principal Ordinance.

- 2. Section Two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the following new definition immediately after the definition "Commissioner":—
 - "Geological Antiquities" means any mineral specimen and includes any fossil or mammal remains of the Territory of scientific or historic interest not falling within any other definition in this Ordinance.

Section 4B added to Principal Ordinance.

- 3. The Principal Ordinance is further amended by inserting therein immediately after Section 4A the following new section:—
 - "4B. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may make regulations for the preservation and acquisition of geological antiquities."
 - Passed in Council this twelfth day of August, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty.
