AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "Police Offences Ordinance, 1912-1938."

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act*, 1905-1934, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Police short title and Offences Ordinance, 1939.
- (2) The Police Offences Ordinance, 1912-1938, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Offences Ordinance*, 1912-1939.

Amendment of Principal Ordinance s. 6A inserted.

2. The Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting therein immediately after Section Six the following new section:—

Lights for vehicles other than motor vehicles.

- "6A. Any person who upon any road street or public place at any time between sunset and sunrise drives any vehicle other than a motor vehicle or rides any bicycle which has not—
 - (a) a lighted lamp or lighted lamps attached to it in such a manner and position as to show a bright white light clearly visible to any person approaching the vehicle or bicycle from the front; and
 - (b) a lighted lamp attached to it in such a manner and position as to show a bright red light clearly visible to any person approaching the vehicle or bicycle from the rear or a red reflector attached to it in such a manner and position as to reflect the lights of a vehicle approaching the vehicle or bicycle from the rear

shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Five pounds."

Passed in Council this eleventh day of August, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
