AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "*Postal Rates (Defence Forces) Ordinance, 1940.*"

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1934*, as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Postal Rates (Defence Forces) Ordinance* (No. 2), 1940. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Postal Rates (Defence Forces) Ordinance, 1940*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Postal Rates (Defence Forces) Ordinances, 1940*.

2. Section Four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding the following further paragraph to the definition "Member of the Forces"—

"(d) a member of the Naval Military or Air Forces of other parts of the British Empire."

3. Sub-paragraph (a) of Section Five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting immediately after the word "Territory" the words "or the Commonwealth or the Territories of New Guinea, Norfolk Island and Nauru."
