# AN ORDINANCE

To Authorize the Deduction of Amounts from Salaries of Officers of the Public Service.

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Service Short Title. (Deduction from Salaries) Ordinance, 1930.
- **2.** This Ordinance shall commence on a date to be commence-fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor by Proclamation in the ment. Gazette.
- 3. In this Ordinance unless the context or subject-Interpretation. matter otherwise requires:—
  - "Lieutenant-Governor" means the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

- "Officer" means any person in the Public Service of the Territory of Papua.
- "Public Service" means the Public Service of the Territory of Papua.
- "Salary" means the remuneration for the time being received by any officer and does not apply to allowances.

## Rate of deduction.

**4.** Deductions shall be made month by month from the salaries of all officers at a rate to be fixed from time to time by the Lieutenant-Governor provided that such rate shall not exceed ten per centum.

## Application of moneys.

**5.** All moneys deducted in pursuance of the provisions of this Ordinance shall belong to and form part of the Public Revenue of the Territory of Papua.

#### Refunds.

**6.** The Lieutenant-Governor may order any moneys deducted in pursuance of this Ordinance to be refunded to the officer entitled thereto.

#### Saving.

7. Nothing herein contained shall affect the rate of salary for the purpose of the Superannuation Ordinance, 1917-1927.

## Suspension or operation.

**8.** The Lieutenant-Governor may at any time by proclamation in the *Gazette* suspend the operation of this Ordinance.

### Regulations.

**9.** The Lieutenant-Governor may make Regulations necessary or convenient for carrying this Ordinance into effect.

Passed in Council this twelfth day of December, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty.
