No. 14 of 1934. AN ORDINANCE

To Provide for Travelling Allowance to the Lieutenant-Governor.

[RESERVED 10TH JULY, 1934; ASSENTED TO 3RD OCTOBER, 1934.] (a)

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act*, 1905-1924, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Service Short title. (Lieutenant-Governor's Travelling Allowance) Ordinance, 1934.
- 2. The Lieutenant-Governor shall be and be deemed Travelling allowance to always to have been entitled to the travelling allowance Lieutenant-expressed to be payable to him under Regulations 24 and 25 of the Public Service Regulations, 1926.

Passed in Council this tenth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

Assented to by His Excellency the Governor-General, with the advice of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia, on the third day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.
