AN ORDINANCE

To Grant and Apply a Sum out of the Revenues of the Territory to the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and eighteen.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Terri-Preamble. tory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. In addition to the sums authorised by the Appropriation Ordinance, 1917-1918, there shall and may be service of issued and applied for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June one thousand nine hundred and eighteen for the purposes set forth in the First Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the sums in the said First Schedule respectively set forth amounting to Six Thousand Three Hundred and Seven Pounds.

Advances for the purposes of the Second Schedule. 2. In addition to the sums specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Appropriation of Loan and Grant Funds.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan and Grant Funds of the Territory towards the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, the sums mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto for the purposes specified therein.

Short title.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance (No. 1), 1917-1918.

Passed in Council this twenty-seventh day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighteen.
