BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Terri-Preamble. tory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. In addition to the sums authorized by the Appropriation Ordinance, 1927-1928, there shall and may be service of issued and applied for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the sums in the said Schedule respectively set forth amounting to Six Thousand Three Hundred and Thirty-five pounds Ten shillings.

Short title.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance (No. 1), 1927-1928.
